Understanding LPN and RN Scope of Practice



State-level Nurse Practice Acts outline the scope of nursing practice, as well as professional and ethical conduct that nurses must adhere to. Typically, each state has its own act.^{1,2}

Michigan eliminated the Nurse Practice Act in 1978 and incorporated all rules and laws regulating health personnel into a new Public Health Code (PA 368 of 1978).³ The Michigan Public Health Code now defines the practice of nursing in Michigan.⁴

Michigan Public Health Code

The Michigan Public Health Code contains limited guidance about the specific job functions RNs and LPNs can perform.⁵ Those that have been defined are included below:

In a public health program ^b without an on-site pharmacy, can be delegated the dispensing of prescription drugs by a dispensing prescriber. <i>MCL</i> 333.17745a (2)	8	⊘

^aA complimentary starter dose is a prescription drug packaged, dispensed and distributed in accordance with state/federal law, that is provided to a dispensing prescriber free of charge by a manufacturer or distributor, and dispensed free of charge by the dispensing prescriber to their patients.

^bA Public Health Program includes all the following: local health department; migrant health center or community health center; family planning program; methadone treatment program; rural health clinic; and hospice rendering emergency services in a patient's home.

Additional guidance about LPN/RN responsibilities in specific settings can be found in the Michigan Public Health Code: Correctional Facilities⁶, Hospice Services.⁷

Administrative Rules of Nursing (LARA)

The Michigan Administrative Code is a compilation of all adopted rules and regulations that are in effect in the State of Michigan.⁸ Additional information from The Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (LARA) Board of Nursing – General Rules⁹ have been outlined below:

Can delegate nursing acts, functions or tasks to other nurses or health professionals.	8	S

Most of the content included in the General Rules pertain to licensure (acquiring initial license and recertifying), nursing education programs, nurse specialty certification and continuing education; and does not include information about scope of practice guidelines.

Condition of Participation (CMS)

Conditions of Participation (CoP) are developed by the CMS, and apply to hospitals and critical access hospitals, among other facility types.¹² CoPs outline requirements which healthcare organizations must meet to participate in federally funded healthcare programs such as Medicare and Medicaid.¹³
