The National Commission to Address Racism in Nursing seeks proposals from organizations working to confront and dismantle racism on the front lines.


The American Nurses Association (ANA), as part of its journey of racial reconciliation, has committed funds to be awarded by the National Commission to Address Racism in Nursing to organizations implementing evidence-informed strategies to dismantle institutional, structural, and systemic racism in nursing.

Through this funding opportunity, the Commission is offering up to \$20,000 to support efforts in eliminating racism in nursing. The funding term will be 18 months from the date of signing. Training and technical support will be provided by ANA and the Commission throughout the duration of funding.
