

INDIANA PATIENT RIGHTS



RIGHTS	VOLUNTARY	INVOLUNTARY
Refuse treatments.	Court ordered treatments cannot be refused. Minors cannot refuse treatment.	Court ordered treatments, including medication, cannot be refused without court approval.
Access information about your rights.		
Consult a doctor of your choice.		
Receive treatment from a doctor of your choice.	If you can pay for it.	You may request a new doctor, but the facility is not required to provide it.
Request release from the facility.	Must give 24 hours' notice. Facility may hold you until court hearing is complete if you are unfit to leave safely.	
File a complaint.		
Participate in creating your treatment plan.		

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Review and copy your medical records.



Contact an attorney of your choice.



Wear your own clothes.

*Conditional right - may be taken away at the facility's discretion.



Keep your belongings.

*Conditional right - may be taken away at the facility's discretion.



Receive phone calls, visits, & mail.
